Union List of Serials

- Being done before 1982
- Included serials, non print media
- For resource and hospital libraries
- TxTech, UNM, RML (2001)
- Latter years closely connected to DOCLINE
- Improved ILL and collection development for many years

Interlibrary Loans

- Originally \$4.00
- ILL Fee \$5.00 in 1984; \$6.00 in 1988;\$7.00 in 1993; \$8.00 in 1996; \$9.00 in 2000
- Fee less than or matched NLM charge
- Coupons in middle 80s
- Ariel 2000

Cooperative Acquisitions

- Cooperative Acquisitions Plan (91)
- Online resources licenses (98)
 - OUHSC
 - TAMU
 - UTSW & UTHSCSA

Research

- Recognized as a goal in 1992
- Developed a cooperative endeavor with SCC to provide Research CE in 1997
- Research grants for librarians in the 5 state region in 1998
- Worked with SCC to provide research awards for posters and papers in 2002

SCAMeL Funding

- Budget in 1982 was \$38,000 (covered by dues, \$.50 fee, fees for services and membership fees)
- Budget in 2006 was \$46,250
- Explanation of \$.50 fee which went to a \$1.00 in EFTS which was instituted in 1998
